Dear Jefferson Raebel,

Please accept this letter as formal notification that Medical Logistics Management- DBA: AirEvac International has been granted an out-of-state recognition license #A055 by the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment. This recognition is valid from July 14, 2020 to July 14, 2021 and applies to the 3 fixed wing aircraft (N669MD, N322PR, and N277MK) and 2 bases (Arizona and Florida Base) identified in your application. As part of the requirements of recognition, outlined in 6 CCR 1015-3 Chapter Five - Rules Pertaining to Air Ambulance Licensing, Medical Logistics Management- DBA: AirEvac International:

- 1) Is granted twelve (12) or fewer flights originating in Colorado between July 14, 2020 and July 14, 2021.
- 2) Must notify the department of any disciplinary or licensing action taken against Medical Logistics Management- DBA: AirEvac International by the licensing authority in any state; and
- 3) Must submit an annual report using the flight tracking form found in your OATH account. The report includes the number of transports flown under the recognition license, the number of patients transported, and the healthcare facilities or locations in Colorado from which patients were transported. You may fill out the flight tracking form after each flight or on an annual bases. Pursuant to department regulations, failure to comply with this reporting requirement may result in action against your recognition license.
